



Delegation of Power of Attorney for Sale of Chometz

I, the undersigned, fully empower and permit a **designated agent from Talmudic University of Florida** to act on my behalf to sell all chometz possessed by me (knowingly or unknowingly) as defined by the torah and Rabbinic law (e.g. chometz, doubt of chometz, and all kinds of chometz mixtures); also chometz that tends to harden and adhere to a surface or inside of pans or pots or cooking and usable utensils and all kinds of live animals that have been eating chometz or mixtures thereof, and to lease all places wherein the chometz owned by me, may be found, especially on the premises located at:

This includes transit goods that would have delivered to me during the period of Monday, April 18 to Tuesday, April 26, 2011 inclusive. **The designated agent** has the full right to sell and to lease my transactions as he deems fit and proper and for such time which he believes necessary, to a non-Jew of his choosing.

Also, I do hereby give designated representative from Talmudic University of Florida full power and authority to appoint a substitute in his stead with full power to sell and lease as provided.

The above-given power is in conformity with all Torah and Rabbinical regulations and laws, and also in accordance with the laws of the State of Florida and of the United States.
